


About the Trust 2016-17

Guy's and St Thomas' is among the UK's busiest, most successful NHS foundation trusts. We provide a full range of hospital and community services for people in Lambeth, Southwark and Lewisham, as well as specialist services for patients from further afield including cancer, renal and cardiovascular.



Evelina London Children's Hospital at St Thomas' provides many specialist services, including treatment for complex heart conditions, as well as general services for local children. We also provide children's community services in Lambeth and Southwark.

St Thomas' has one of the largest critical care units in the UK and one of the busiest A&E departments in London. Guy's is home to the largest dental school in Europe and a new £160 million Cancer Centre opened in autumn 2016.



Our adult community services teams work at the heart of our local communities, working closely with many other healthcare organisations, GPs, local authorities and voluntary and community groups. They provide a range of services across Lambeth and Southwark in many locations including in GP surgeries, clinics and health centres and in patients' homes.

We have a reputation for clinical excellence and high quality teaching and research. We are part of King's Health Partners, one of six accredited UK Academic Health Sciences Centres. We have dedicated clinical research facilities and a National Institute for Health Research (NIHR) Biomedical Research Centre in partnership with King's College London.



Patients are at the heart of everything we do and we pride ourselves on ensuring the best possible patient experience as well as safe, high quality care.



This was reflected in our comprehensive Care Quality Commission (CQC) inspection in 2015/16. We achieved a 'good' overall rating. Evelina London Children's Hospital and our

Emergency Department (A&E) were rated as 'outstanding'. We are proud to have one of the lowest mortality rates in the NHS, including out-of-hours and at weekends.



The commitment of our 15,300 staff is key to our success. As one of the largest local employers, we aim to develop all our staff so they are equipped to deliver high quality, efficient and effective services. Guy's and St Thomas' achieved the top ranking for staff engagement in trusts in England in the national NHS Staff Survey.

We have one of the largest capital investment programmes anywhere in the NHS.
