

St Thomas' Hospital entrance walkway resurfacing project June - August 2015

From 22 June – late August 2015 we will be resurfacing the pedestrian walkway at St Thomas' Hospital from Westminster Bridge Road to the main entrance. The project will improve rainwater drainage and create a smooth and even surface through the installation of new paving.

Pedestrian access from Westminster Bridge Road to the main entrance will be maintained at all times. Work will be carried out in phases and signs will be in place to direct patients and staff during each phase.

Access to the Outpatients Department, INPUT Pain Management and Pain Management Outpatients in Gassiot House will be maintained.

Please note the following during construction:

- Construction work will be carried out in phases to minimise disruption. However, there will be noise during certain activities. This will be closely managed to minimise the impact on clinical services and patient care.
- Construction work will take place from 8am - 5pm seven days a week
- Noisy works will be carried out before 9am and at weekends wherever possible to minimise disruption
- The bicycle racks next to the pedestrian walkway will be relocated to the front of Gassiot House, near the Outpatients Department entrance, for the duration of the project.
