New cancer centre at Guy's Hospital



Due for completion: Autumn 2016

We are currently building a new, state of the art cancer centre at Guy's Hospital.

The centre will be a hub for South East London, providing specialist cancer services, training, development and research, and allowing us to provide better cancer treatments and improved outcomes for our patients.

By having our patients come to single site for both their cancer diagnosis and their ongoing cancer treatment, the new centre will assist us in providing a seamless stream of care.

Functional, state of the art design

The cancer centre will be divided into 'zones' or 'villages', with most of the related treatment facilities grouped together in one place. The 'villages' will have balconies to allow light into the building and provide outdoor space.

The ground floor Welcome Zone will provide a rehabilitation gym, drop-in facilities, the Dimbleby Cancer Care Centre, retail space and a café. The latest technology will be used to streamline the patient's route around the building.



Please note the following during your visit:

The construction phase of the new cancer centre will begin in Summer 2013.

We have been working closely with our contractors to develop a construction plan designed to minimise disruption to clinical services. As far as is possible, we will try to keep any disturbance, such as noise and dust, to a minimum. However, noise is not completely unavoidable, and you may notice some disruption during piling work and when the foundations are laid.

Works which are known to be very disruptive to patients, staff or visitors will be undertaken, wherever possible, at weekends.
