

Your multi-disciplinary team and your key worker (specialist nurse) – supporting you during your prostate cancer treatment

Your care is managed by a multi-disciplinary team (MDT). This means that a range of clinical staff, including urologists, oncologists, radiologists, pathologists and specialist nurses are involved in your treatment. The team meets to discuss every patient when they are diagnosed to ensure that everyone is offered the best treatment for their individual needs, including clinical trials where appropriate. This is called an MDM or multi-disciplinary meeting.

A team of specialist nurses can be contacted for advice, information and support during your cancer treatment. This information sheet lets you know who your main contact from that team (called your 'key worker') will be and how to contact him/her to talk or ask any questions you may have. You can email or phone your key worker or arrange a time to meet in person.


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
