1 Before your appointment

The Cancer Centre at Guy's is near to London Bridge Station.



2 When you get to the hospital

When you arrive in the Welcome Village, use a check-in kiosk to let us know you're here. Follow the instructions on screen. If you're having radiotherapy, go to the Radiotherapy Village on floor R to check in.



3 Checking in

The screens in the waiting area, or your buzzer, will let you know when your appointment is nearly due.

To get a buzzer, or if you need help, please speak to a member of staff.



4 Getting to your village

Check the village you need to go to. The main lifts can only take you to the **arrival floor** of each village.

The village lifts take you to other levels within that village.



5 Getting to the right village level

When you arrive, use the check-in kiosk or speak to reception to let us know you're here.

You'll be called for your appointment.

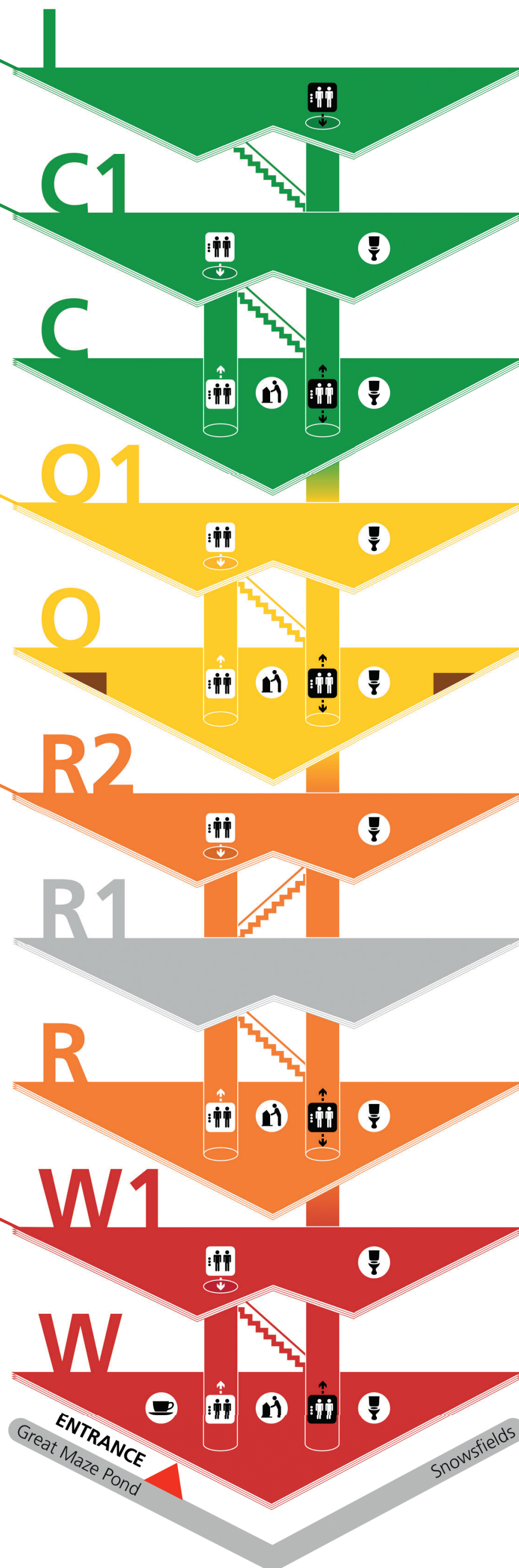

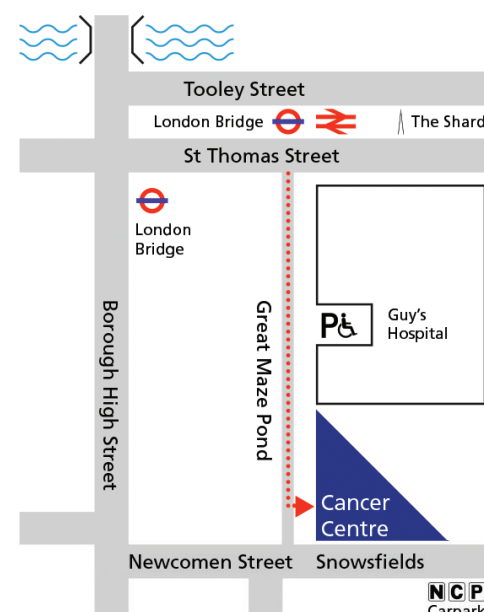

How to use this map

The building is divided into individual villages, not traditional floors.

Use the main lifts to go to the arrival level of each village. Use the village lifts and stairs to go between levels of each village.

When you arrive, all patients should report to the main self check-in. This is in the Welcome Village on the ground floor.
