## What happens if you are sick and might not get better





Your healthcare team might not be sure if you will get better.



In Guy's and St Thomas' hospitals, you will get care and treatment called the **AMBER care bundle**.



Your healthcare team will check how you are every day.



If there are any changes in your health, they will give you the right treatment.



They will ask where you want to be looked after if you do not get better.



If you want, they can tell people important to you how you are.

This may include family, friends or support workers.



The **AMBER care bundle** helps you get the right care.



It also helps others understand how you want to be looked after if you do not get better.
